- Teaches content and skills in English language, literature, composition, and reading to high school students.
- Adapts English material and methods to develop relevant sequential assignments and lesson plans that guide and challenge students.
- Encourages students to think independently and to express original ideas.
- Evaluates each student's progress in meeting the course standards for English skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing).
- Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive classroom environment.
- Identifies student needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve learning, health and attitude problems.
