All summer programming positions depend upon funding and are assumed to be temporary and guaranteed only for the current year.

LENGTH OF CONTRACT

- These summer programs will operate 4 days a week for 5 weeks, Mon – Thurs, June 28 - July 29. Staff hours will be 7:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. and student hours will be 8:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. There will be a possible Waterpark Trip on July 30th.
- Up to 3 Inservice Dates - June 22 - 24, 2021. **Exact dates to be determined.**

POSITION DESCRIPTION

- These 5-week blended programs incorporate academic support and enrichment activities for students who have just completed PreK – 6th.
- Assist Summer Programming Teacher to enhance the academic performance and to enrich the lives of Baker School District students.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to physically perform job duties.
- Ability to hike and supervise students on physical excursions.
- Frequently required to walk, sit, use hands for fine manipulation, handle or feel and reach with hands and arms.
- Frequently required to stand and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl.
